Here are some news items relating to **strategy and management consultancy**. These may be of interest to you if you are researching consulting and – as I emphasise in my classroom presentations and online webinars – information like this could spark an idea that leads to a job opportunity.

There are **fewer consultancy opportunities** around now than before. Competition for them is fierce, from other business school graduates and industry hires. However, you can improve your chances by looking for unadvertised roles as well. If you've heard me share my tips and tricks for uncovering the hidden jobs in consultancy, you'll know that – amongst other things - I recommend looking out for signs that recruitment might be imminent. These include:

- investment from a venture capital fund
- acquisition
- new office
- new partners/directors
- new service line

I mention some of these below.

Expanding...

- **BearingPoint UK** is to add another **200 consultants** to its SalesForce consultancy team by 2025. <u>https://tinyurl.com/5n7nfddj</u> The firm works across 14 industries in Europe, the Americas, Africa, the Middle East and Asia Pacific. Go to <u>https://www.bearingpoint.com/en-gb/our-people/careers/</u> for careers.
- Deloitte UK has big growth plans. As well as taking over a London-based tech consultancy, Reformis, whose 80+ staff join Deloitte's tech advisory business, it has revealed it will hire an additional 3500 new consultants by 2028 in a £200m+ recruitment drive. Deloitte's target means that its workforce will be increasing by 40% (7500 to 11000). In line with its Big Four competitors, Deloitte is capitalising on the demand for cybersecurity, cloud computing and digital infrastructure advice from businesses and government. https://tinyurl.com/tfxrmnwv
- California is the latest site for supply chain and logistics consultancy SCALA <u>https://tinyurl.com/bdcrbm3s</u>, joining operating centres in China, Germany, Ireland and the UK.

Website Consulting Sourcing has a report on **internal consulting** <u>https://tinyurl.com/4b8yd9xe</u>, highlighting the growth of consulting units within corporates.

A study from the Managing Partners Forum <u>https://tinyurl.com/5fdrkbhj</u> found that many consultancy firms are determined to **maintain headcount targets** despite market difficulties. This is because shedding consultants, or failing to hire newbies now, might see firms hit by a talent shortage in the future. And many firms remain confident about their prospects in the short term: a

survey <u>https://tinyurl.com/yp8cwhms</u> has found that **77%** of consultancies **expect to grow** their revenues and profit margins.

Overall demand for consulting services is still strong - but less predictable, says Source Research Group <u>https://tinyurl.com/3mjprzmv</u> Productivity improvement and cost reduction projects are flavour of the month with **public sector** clients, and those in **manufacturing**, **pharma and healthcare**. This segment is expected to grow by 8% in 2023. **Strategy consulting** is also robust, particularly in **SE Asia**. Source calculates the global consulting market was worth **\$235bn in 2022** – with strategy about 7% of the total.
