PwC fined \$67m and banned from China for 6 months due to their part in the Evergrande collapse in 2021. This has led to PwC stopping a [\\$140m investment](#) in China.

The [Consulting Report](#) has announced the top 25 healthcare consulting leaders of 2024. Their article predicts that the sector is going to grow by 9.5% annually until 2031.

Mastering the Case Interview

As the recruitment season heats up, consultancies are on the lookout for the next wave of talented analysts and consultants. At the heart of this process? The case interview - a rigorous test designed to simulate the complex, high-pressure problem-solving that defines a consultant's role. Success in these interviews requires more than just sharp analytical skills; it demands a structured, strategic approach and the ability to think on your feet.

What Are They Looking For?

- **MECE Mindset:** Can you structure problems in a Mutually Exclusive, Collectively Exhaustive way?
- **Strategic Thinking:** Are you seeing the forest or just the trees?
- **Data Wizardry:** Can you crunch numbers and interpret charts without a calculator as your crutch?
- **Business Savvy:** Do you understand what makes companies tick?
- **Executive Presence:** Can you communicate like a seasoned pro and hold your own in a boardroom?

Here's how you can prepare effectively and avoid common pitfalls:

1. Practice, Practice, Practice!

Talent alone won't get you through a case interview. Even the most gifted candidates need extensive practice to excel. Engaging in mock interviews, either in groups or with a coach, can make a dramatic difference. The more you practice, the more comfortable and confident you'll become in tackling complex cases.

2. Keep It Strategic, Not Detail-Obsessed

It's easy to get bogged down in the minutiae. However, focusing too much on details can sideline your strategic thinking. Aim to maintain a high-level perspective and steer the case with a clear, strategic approach. Avoid getting lost in the weeds—focus on leading the case effectively.

3. Avoid the Scattergun Approach

Don't list every possible cause or solution right away. This scattergun approach often signals a lack of clear hypothesis and strategic focus. Instead, develop a well-thought-out hypothesis and use it to guide your analysis and recommendations.

4. Showcase Leadership and Presence

Most case interviews are led by the candidate (with exceptions like McKinsey or BCG's online cases). Interviewers are looking for more than just analytical prowess—they want to see how you navigate complexity and ambiguity with professionalism and poise. Frame your analysis as a compelling narrative, ask insightful questions, and remember to engage with a confident smile.

5. Don't Forget to include Actionable Outcomes

Always ask yourself, "So what?" and "What next?" Translate your analysis into actionable recommendations. The goal is to determine what the data implies and what else may be needed. Your ability to provide clear, actionable next steps will demonstrate your business acumen and strategic thinking.
